Düsseldorf, 10. November 2025 – The Breidenbacher Hof, one of Germany's most traditional grand hotels, has unveiled its newly redesigned Living Room after a two-month renovation period. As the heart of the property and a central meeting point for guests from around the world, the space now presents itself in a completely refreshed look. The lobby, too, shines in new splendor: the former blue and beige tones have been replaced with elegant accents in green and cognac, giving the ambience a contemporary warmth and subtle modernity.

The design, created by interior architect Peter Silling, blends timeless elegance with a modern, residential-inspired aesthetic that reinterprets homeliness, exclusivity and private retreat spaces.

Covering around 180 square meters, the Living Room has undergone a comprehensive redesign in recent weeks. All surfaces, furnishings and lighting elements are bespoke pieces crafted specifically for this project in Europe and Asia. The result is a harmonious fusion of classical craftsmanship and contemporary design language – a space that continues the story of the hotel while defining the aspirations of a new generation of luxury hospitality.

"The art lies in ensuring that even in modern design, the grand hotel remains unmistakably present," says Peter Silling of his creative vision.

The new layout creates various zones for different needs: quiet retreats for reading and working, open areas for conversation and socializing and the Culinary Corner, which has been designed as a separate private space. Generous seating groups, exquisite materials and finely tuned lighting moods lend the room a warm, inviting atmosphere – fully in keeping with the hotel's philosophy of interpreting luxury as personal comfort and sanctuary.

The design follows a clear goal: to make the Breidenbacher Hof's service ethos and hospitality culture tangible in spatial form. The Living Room not only being a lounge, but also the workplace of the Personal Assistants, who act here as discreet hosts fulfilling guests' wishes – from spontaneous concert tickets to personalized city tours and tailor-made leisure arrangements.
